Library closing, exciting upgrade gets under way

Burwood Library and Community Hub will be closed temporarily from 1 December to allow for an exciting transformation project.

This will include an upgraded library, new community spaces and Council's customer service staff moving to the site.

There will be creative spaces, indoor and balcony gardens, better digital technology, a dedicated youth zone and more spaces for children.

Borrowing and returning items will not be possible during the works.

However before that time, the borrowing limit will be increased to 60 items. Loan periods will be extended until after the library re-opens.

Online services, which include audiobooks, e-books and movies, will remain available.

Council will provide regular updates to keep you abreast of progress.

The library is expected to re-open by mid-2020.

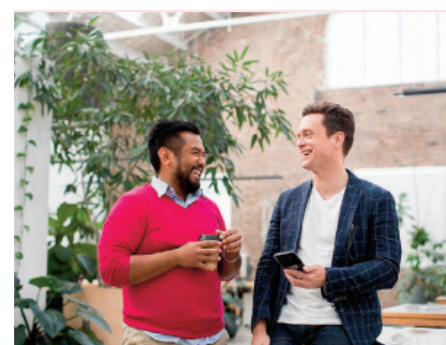
Staff will be available to answer questions during the closure on the library phone number: 9911 9999.
