Pensioner Rebate

As of 1 July 2019, Council continues to increase its contribution to the Pensioner Rebate from \$50 to \$75 on top of the \$250 mandatory rebate, bringing the total to \$325 for eligible pensioners in the Burwood Local Government Area.
