

Proposed Works

Parramatta Road and Luke Avenue Pedestrian Crossing

May 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wangal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Parramatta Road Urban Amenity Improvement Program (PRUAIP) is an initiative by the NSW Department of Planning and Environment to improve open space and active transport links along the Parramatta Road corridor. The program brings state agencies and local councils together to collaborate on projects that improve public amenity on the corridor.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW is delivering improvements to Parramatta Road to provide a continuous walking and cycling route from Concord Oval to Luke Avenue, giving more options to walk, cycle or move around the surrounding area.

The work will include:

- the installation of signalised pedestrian crossing on the eastern leg of the intersection
- new traffic lights on the southwest corner of the intersection for westbound traffic on Parramatta Road
- new kerb ramps for easy access for wheelchair users and parents with prams
- Improvements to shared path adjacent to Concord Oval
- new no stopping zone on Luke Avenue.

When and where we'll be working

We will be on site for up to 60 shifts, for no more than five night shifts per week. Work is scheduled between Sunday 7 May up to Sunday 20 August 2023.

Our night shift hours will be between 7pm to 5am, Monday to Sunday. No work will be performed Friday and Saturday night or public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

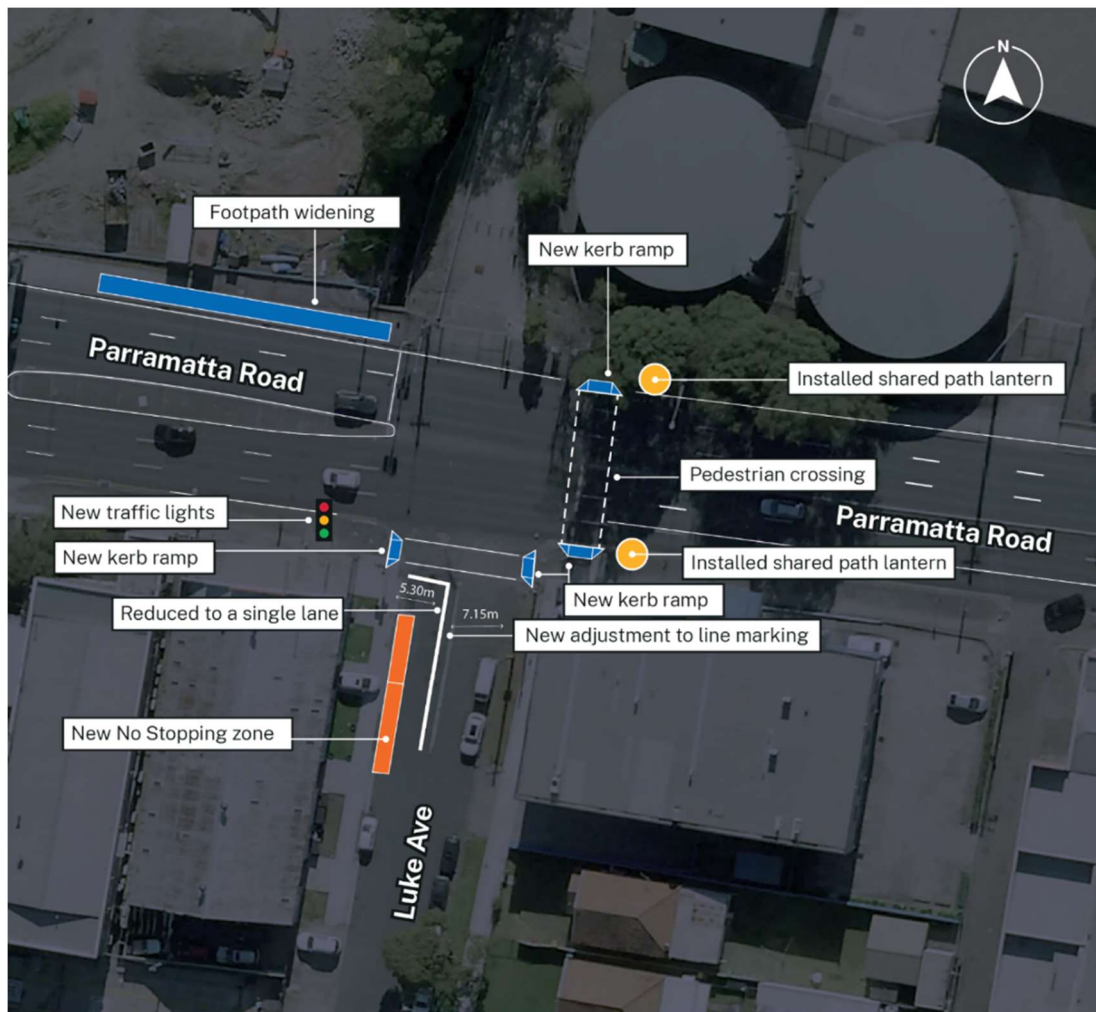
Our work may be noisy at times, and we appreciate this can be inconvenient. We will do everything we can to minimise impact including completing the noisier tasks by midnight. During our work you may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Traffic Changes

There will be temporary traffic changes while workers are on site. A work zone speed limit of 40 km/h will be applied to maintain safety of workers and motorists. Temporary lane and footpath closures may be required, traffic flow and access to properties will be maintained at all times. Please keep to speed limits and follow directional signage and guidance from traffic control.
