Floodlights Upgrade in Henley Park

I am thrilled to see that Council's floodlight upgrade project is well underway in Henley Park. The installation of 13 new floodlights is expected to complete in the coming weeks.

This will provide safe access for park users, and enable our sporting teams to train and play during the evenings and especially during the winter months where there is lack of natural lighting.

Earlier this year Council received \$165,000 contribution from Enfield Rovers Club towards the total cost for the upgrade of \$500,000.
