Community Grants Recipients Announced

This year Council provided \$40,000 Community Grants to 14 successful community organisations.

I am confident that their activities or projects will deliver social, cultural, recreational or environmental benefits to our local community.



Supporting Our Senior Members

As Mayor, I understand our seniors' difficulties in managing their expenses due to the increasing cost of living in Sydney.

That is why Council has made a concentrated effort to reduce the financial burden by increasing our Pensions Rebate from \$250 to \$375 – a 50% increase over four years that commenced in 2018.

In the 2019-2020 Financial Year, Council will increase the Pension Rebate to \$325 and in 2020-2021 Financial Year to \$375, which will provide our seniors members in the community with greater security and long term benefits.



Shopfront Upgrade

Council will be trialling a Shopfront Improvement Program within eligible locations in the Burwood LGA for a period of up to 12 months.

This grant program encourages business owners to upgrade the appearance of shopfronts, with Council contributing 50% of the overall eligible project cost of the upgrade to a maximum of \$5,000 to any eligible project. It is expected that the program will achieve a refreshed street experience for the local community and visitors whilst empowering business owners to start/continue to improve their business and build a sense of pride as well as increasing the economic activity in the Burwood town centre.



Honouring Our Nashos

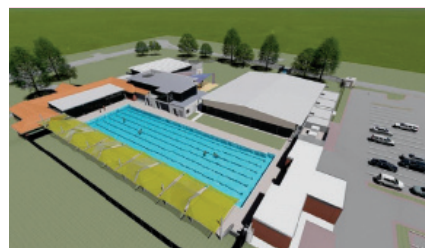
Last Sunday our community came together in commemoration of the sacrifice and courage of our National Servicemen who were called upon to protect and defend our nation and the Commonwealth.
