



Continuing Our Works Program

Council will soon begin the following upgrades to the **Grant Park dog off-leash** areas which includes
Installing new perimeter fence and gates; two additional solar lights; two new bubblers with dog bowls; relocating existing dog grooming bench; reeturf ing the area fronting the picnic shelter and the planting of five Corymbia 'Summer Red' trees. We are also extending the usage hours for the off leash areas from 6am-9pm.

As part of the project to enhance the grounds within Woodstock, Council will be replacing the old playground equipment and adding a small flying fox as well as extending the high screen fencing; installing new BBQ units, picnic tables and benches and adding a new sensory garden.
