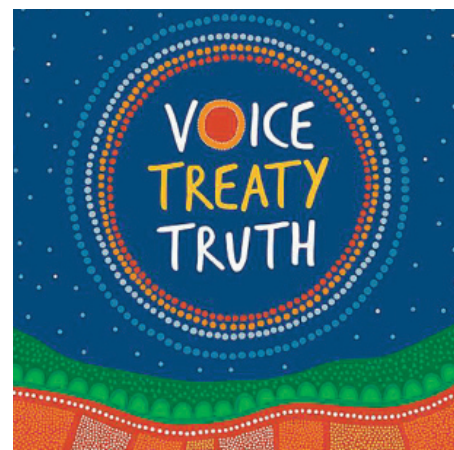
Celebrate NAIDOC Week
