\$10 million upgrade to library and new community spaces

I'm excited to announce council will spend almost \$10 million significantly upgrading Burwood Library and providing new multipurpose community spaces.

The proposed design will be a great place for learning, study and meetings, and provide access to better digital technology. Council recently asked our community for input into what a modern library and new community spaces might be like.

We intend to include these insights into the design phase such as makers space, music rooms, art exhibition space, more seating and quiet zones.

I'm looking forward to our children using the upgraded library and new community spaces to become more technology savvy and encouraging their interest in reading and creativity.

Works could start later this year. We will provide more details soon.
