WestInvest success continues with a total \$96 million boost for our community

We were thrilled earlier this year to receive word that three more of our ambitious projects put forward for WestInvest funding have been successful!

These projects are:

- \$52.4 million to redevelop the Enfield Aquatic Centre
- \$20.3 million contribution towards the Burwood Urban Park and Arts and Cultural Centre
- \$3.9 million for the Paisley Road Beautification Project to transform the connecting area between Burwood and Croydon Station

This funding is in addition to the \$21 million already received through the WestInvest Local Government Allocation Round. Combined that's almost \$100 million going right back into our community, leaving a legacy of world-class spaces for generations to come.

I couldn't be happier to see this result for our community. Read more about these fantastic projects on page 2!

Burwood Council has signed up to one of the biggest renewable energy agreements for local government! On 1 January 2023, all Burwood Council facilities switched to being powered by 100% renewable energy from three NSW solar farms through electricity retailer Zen Energy.

In the coming months Council will be unveiling a new urban pond with upgraded stormwater infrastructure. This upgrade will assist in managing heavy rains along Comer Street and Burwood Road while also utilsing filtered rain water for the pond itself.

This project is scheduled for completion in June 2023.


Sewing Bee Club
