

8.1 Eligibility

- Anyone wishing to submit a work must complete the entry form, including signing the Artist Declaration.
- The competition is only open to those 16 years and over (as at 29 March 2019).
- The competition is open to residents of the Burwood, Canada Bay and Strathfield Local Government Areas or demonstrated connection to one of those areas (evidence may be required).
- Submissions under the New and Emerging Artist category will also be considered for Artwork of the Year and the People's Choice award.
- There is no entry fee.
- Entries must be in the form of a painting in any medium including acrylic, water colour and oil.
- Digital artworks will not be accepted as well as artworks with items attached that may come loose, such as beading or paper materials.
- No photographic artwork will be accepted.
- Entries must be an original work by the artist and must have been completed after 1 January 2015.
- Entries are limited to one artwork per artist.
- Burwood Council reserves the right to reject artworks in its absolute discretion for the Burwood Art Prize, including work deemed, in its absolute discretion, to be of an offensive nature.
- Burwood Council may choose to photograph or film submitted artworks and use the images for publication and promotional purposes and the artist/entrant grants a licence to the Council to do so.
- Staff of Burwood Council are not eligible to enter the competition.

8.2 How to Enter

- Submission of the 2019 Burwood Art Prize Entry Form must be provided by 5.00pm on Friday, 29 March 2019 to arts@burwood.nsw.gov.au
- Entrants must submit their artwork to Burwood Library and Community Hub (2 Conder Street, Burwood) between 10am and 2pm on 30 May 2019 or between 3pm and 7pm on 31 May 2019. Entries will not be accepted before 10am or after 2pm on 30 May 2019 and before 3pm or after 7pm on 31 May 2019.
- A 'confirmation of entry' will be issued when artwork is submitted. The confirmation of entry will need to be kept and will be required for the collection of the artwork at the conclusion of the exhibition period.

8.3 Licensing the Work

- Artist/entrant grants to Burwood Council, its successors and assigns a non-exclusive licence to reproduce the artist's work in material form, to photograph, publish and/or communicate it to the public for Burwood Council purposes and for the following prize related purposes and anything incidental to such purposes by Burwood Council its servants, agents and employees:
 - Marketing, publicity and publication uses for the Burwood Council, the Burwood Art prize and its exhibition and all media in perpetuity in any print exhibition, catalogue which may be used for the purposes of the 2019 Burwood Art Prize and any future Burwood Art Prizes.

8.4 Artwork Specifications

- Entries must be paintings in any medium and dry (wet paintings will not be accepted).
- The paintings must include the artist's name, contact phone number and/or email address and title of work, with this information to be securely attached to the back.
- Paintings must be no larger than 100cm by 100cm (including the frame) and must be no heavier than 25 kilograms.
- Paintings must be framed and/or include suitable hanging devices - i.e. a suitable cord or wire with two flat D-rings on the back of the artwork.
- Frames and paintings must be stable and secure in their construction to minimise any damage during handling.
- If a painting depicts an identifiable individual or group, the consent of the person(s) must be obtained by the artist and submitted with the painting (see section 5).
- If possible, a high resolution JPEG image of the artwork should also be supplied when the entry form or artwork are submitted. Email artwork image to: arts@burwood.nsw.gov.au

8.5 Prizes

- There are three categories of awards.
- The following are the prizes for each award category:
 - Artwork of the Year: \$5,000
 - New and Emerging Artist: \$2,500
 - People's Choice: \$1,000
- The Artwork of the Year and the New and Emerging Artist categories are acquisitive, meaning the winning artworks in those categories will become the property of Burwood Council.
- Council reserves the right to do as it chooses with acquired artworks, i.e. to display, store, sell or dispose of them, at its discretion.

8.6 Copyright of Artwork

- For artworks that become the property of Burwood Council, the artist will retain the copyright and Burwood Council will acknowledge the artist on any reproduction of the prize-winning work, wherever possible.
- The artist/entrant warrants and represents that any material sent or provided by the artist/entrant to Burwood Council including the artwork will not infringe any copyright, trademarks or other intellectual property rights of any third party and that the artist/entrant has all rights to use the materials and has obtained all necessary consents to comply with any relevant privacy and/or confidentiality requirements.

8.7 Reproduction of Artwork

Burwood Council reserves the right to use images of artworks entered into the 2019 Burwood Art Prize for the purposes of documentation, publicity, catalogues provided in paper or digital format along with general use of Burwood Council initiatives such as via website/social media content and public art. Burwood Council will make appropriate acknowledgements.

8.8 Judging

A panel will be established by Council to shortlist and judge the artworks, and their decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

8.9 Winning Entries

The winning entries will be announced at the 2019 Burwood Art Prize Awards Ceremony to be held on Friday, 21 June 2019.

*[To be retained by the applicant]***8.10 Exhibition of Artworks**

- Shortlisted artworks will be exhibited at the Burwood Library and Community Hub, 2 Conder Street, Burwood from Friday, 21 June 2019 until Sunday, 30 June 2019.
- Artworks entered into the competition must be available to Burwood Council from the entry date until the conclusion of the exhibition period.
- Exhibited artworks will be professionally mounted and dismantled and appropriately secured by Council and the artist/entrant grants permission to the Council to so exhibit their work.
- The location of any exhibited artworks at these premises shall be in the absolute discretion of Burwood Council.
- All shortlisted artworks and the names of the artists/entrants may be promoted through the Burwood Council website and other promotional activity deemed appropriate by Burwood Council including print publications, social media and other websites.
- The entrant/artist will participate in and cooperate as required with all reasonable marketing and editorial activities relating to the Burwood Art Prize.

8.11 Collection of Artworks

- Artworks will only be released upon presentation of confirmation receipt of entry.
- Artworks must be collected at the end of the exhibition from the Burwood Library and Community Hub on Monday, 1 July 2019 between 10am-4pm.
- Arrangements to collect artworks after this date may be made by contacting 9911 9905 (subject to the point below).
- If any artist/entrant does not retrieve their artwork by 5.00pm on Tuesday, 9 July 2019 Burwood Council will give two (2) weeks' notice of its intention to sell or otherwise dispose of the artwork, by sending a notice by post to the artist/entrant at the last known address. The Council may then sell the work and, after deducting from the proceeds the cost of and incidental to the sale, shall hold any balance for the artist/entrant. If, however, it is of the opinion of Burwood Council that the work is unsaleable then Burwood Council may destroy or otherwise dispose of it in any manner they deem fit and shall be under no liability whatsoever to the artist/entrant in respect of the artwork so disposed of or destroyed.

8.12 Insurance

- Artists are responsible for insuring their artworks against theft or damage during transit and throughout the exhibition.
- Burwood Council is not or its agents, servants and employees are not responsible for entries during transit, installation, exhibition and removal. Burwood Council, their servants, agents and contractors, while taking all care shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to any entry, and the responsibility belongs to the artist/entrant. Burwood Council recommends that all artists/entrants arrange their own insurance for the exhibition and to cover against damage, loss or theft.

8.13 Sale of Artworks

- Non-winning entries to the competition and the entry that wins the non-acquisitive People's Choice Prize may be sold through an independent arrangement between the artist and the buyer.
- The entries that win the Artwork of the Year and the New and Emerging Artist Prizes cannot be sold by the artist, as those artworks become the property of Council (refer section 8.5).
- Artists must notify Council that the artwork is For Sale (FS) and must provide a contact phone number (see section 4a), all of which will be displayed on the description board featured underneath artwork in the exhibition.
- Any artist not advising that the artwork is FS will have a Not For Sale (NFS) featured underneath the artwork in the exhibition.
- A sold artwork cannot be collected from Council by the buyer.
- Council and its staff will have no involvement in such arrangements.
